

How to Get FAA Wings Credit for Your CAPF-5 Check Ride

This series of annotated screenshots illustrates how to obtain FAA Wings credit for your CAPF-5 check ride.

1. Use your web browser to access the FAA Safety website at <http://www.faasafety.gov>. You will get their home page. It will look like the screenshot below.
 - a. If you are already registered, enter your email address and password, then click the “Go button,” which is the white arrow in the blue box.
 - b. If you are not registered, click the “Get registered with FAASafety.gov” button and then just fill in the blanks.

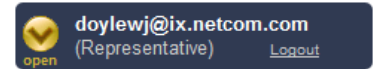

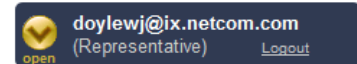

7. You will get a screen view similar to the one shown below.
 - a. Enter the date that you took and passed you CAPF-5 Check Ride.
 - b. Select the CFI that you want to validate your check ride.
 - i. Preferably, this will be the check pilot who administered your checkride.
 - ii. It can also be NJWG/DOV or NJWG/DOVA
 - c. Click the "Submit for Validation" button.

9. When your check pilot validates your submission, you will receive notification from the FAA and then you will be able to get a PDF file with your WINGS certificate. The PDF file has three certificates
 - a. A large size Wings Certificate, suitable for framing
 - b. A wallet size Wings Certificate, suitable for framing suitable for laminating and keeping in your wallet.
 - c. A wallet size Flight Review Certificate, suitable for suitable for laminating and keeping in your wallet. It is also suggested that you tape a copy of this in the back of your logbook.
