## Heraldry of the 2014 JOINT DAKOTA ENCAMPMENT LOGO

The 2014 Joint Dakota Encampment was held 12-20 July 2014 at Camp Grafton, the main Army National Guard installation in North Dakota, located near Devils Lake.

Joint Dakota Encampments alternate between Camp Grafton, ND in even numbered years and Camp Rapid, SD in odd numbered years.

The five-color logo for the 2014 Joint Dakota Encampment is in the traditional shape of a shield with a scroll at the bottom. The logo is outlined in yellow. The field is divided diagonally with the left portion in blue and the right portion in red. In the blue field is depicted the shoulder patch of the North Dakota Wing. In the red field is depicted the South Dakota Wing shoulder patch. The field of the scroll is white and bears "JDCLE 2014" in blue which stands for Joint Dakota Cadet Leadership Encampment and the year. The theme at this encampment emphasized teaching cadets the fine art of leadership. Customarily, each flight at an encampment wears a different color t-shirt. The example shown below is on a black t-shirt worn by members of the encampment staff. Although not part of the logo, the motto for this encampment was "Only the BEST come North".

It is not currently known who designed the logo. North Dakota Wing's Lt. Col. Dean Reiter, the Encampment Commander, was most likely the official who approved the logo for wear.
