2017 JOINT DAKOTA CADET LEADERSHIP ENCAMPMENT LOGO

The 2017 Joint Dakota Cadet Leadership Encampment was held 08-16 July 2017 at Camp Rapid, the main Army National Guard installation in South Dakota, located near Rapid City. Joint Dakota Encampments alternate between Camp Rapid, SD in odd numbered years and Camp Grafton, ND in even numbered years.

The multicolor logo for the 2017 Joint Dakota Cadet Leadership Encampment is in the traditional shape of a shield with a banner at the top and a scroll at the bottom. The logo is outlined in yellow. The field is divided diagonally with the left portion in dark blue and the right portion in red. In the blue field is depicted the shoulder patch of the North Dakota Wing. In the blue portion, on a slant from lower left to upper right is the Latin motto which translates as "From possibility to actuality". In the red field is depicted the South Dakota Wing shoulder patch. At bottom center, in the red portion, in yellow are the words "75 Years of Cadets" marking 2017 as the 75th Anniversary of the Civil Air Patrol's cadet program which was founded in 1942. The banner at the top of the shield marks 2017 as the 25th Anniversary of the Joint Dakotas Encampments. The field of the banner at the top is white with the lettering in blue. The field of the scroll at the bottom is white and bears the name and date of the activity in blue. Both the banner and the scroll are edged in yellow.



The logo was designed by Cadet Captain Levi Woodard of Rushmore Composite Squadron (Rapid City) in May 2017 and approved for wear by the Encampment Commander, SDWG Capt. Michael Johnson shortly thereafter.

As a private initiative, Cadet Captain Woodard, at the behest of Captain Jonson, designed a subdued version of the encampment logo for wear on a sand-colored tee-shirt. As a private purchase item the subdued logo lacks

some of the preciseness of the full-color version, most notably detailing on the banner and the scroll. About 20 of these tee-shirts were produced and offered at cost to encampment staff members. A few members purchased these variant tee-shirts and wore them during the encampment as part of their uniform. As these sand-colored tee-shirts were worn with the approval of Capt. Johnson they are considered an official variant of the full-color logo on grey tee-shirt.
